

Summary of BOD meeting 13 March @ Lewiston, ID.
The morning was taken up by reports by the treasurer, Broomtales editor and national business reports. Education, Public Lands reports were presented. A discussion of the lists that BCHI & BCHA newsletters are mailed to was held.

After a fantastic Dutch Oven lunch was served the afternoon business resumed.

Mark Bogar the Ways & Means chair gave a talk on the methods used to generate income for BCHI. This included reports from each chapter on how calendar sales for 2010 had gone. Several of the chapters had struggled to sell their calendars. After some discussion on methods that had met with success and what had not worked out a canvas was conducted to determine the number of calendars each chapter would try to sell next year. There were some adjustments made for those that had struggled to sell the current bunch. It was ultimately decided that for 2011 we will again order 2000 calendars.
The list of complaints about the 2010 edition was gone over and areas to improve upon discussed.

Chapter reports were given and all chapters present have a full agenda planned for this season.

Resolutions, proposals and chapter issues were discussed.

The idea of teleconferencing BOD meetings was talked about. The consensus was that most members would prefer to continue with the present forum.

Assignment of a rotation system for hosting BOD and Convention was discussed. Raynette Didier will present a suggested system at the July meeting.

Disposition of calendar income was debated.

Robin Schindele presented the new poster for hiker education. It will be available for viewing at the next meeting.

The Trailer Sticker issues were debated. Whit gave an eloquent presentation in favor of the proposal however it failed to carry. With the exception of TVBCH the delegates declined the proposal claiming their membership had mandated them to vote against the sticker.
